Students must begin this course as soon as possible to ensure completion before August 1st. A completed waiver must be on file or a schedule change from your previously requested electives may occur to include PE.

<u>PE Waiver Statement</u>: Senate Bill 610 requires the equivalent of one class period per day of physical education for one semester of each year for students in grades 6 - 8. The physical education requirement shall be waived for a student who meets one of the following criteria: a) The student is enrolled or required to enroll in a remedial course, b) the parent requests that the student enroll in another course from among those offered as options by the school district, or c) the student is participating in physical activities outside the school day, which are equal to or in excess of the mandated requirement.
