Complete the application and turn into the PTSA mailbox or email the application to csrmsptsa@gmail.com.

4. Is there a budget limit?

The grant proposal may not exceed \$100.

5. How do I receive my grant items?

Once your grant has been approved by the PTSA Board of Directors please submit your items wanted by email to csrmsptsa@gmail.com and they will be purchased by the PTSA and delivered.

6. How will my application be evaluated?

All applications will be presented during our regular and general PTSA meetings. The mini-grant will be evaluated based upon how the proposed project supports the curriculum, impact it will have on students, and for the clarity of the budget presentation. Grants will be awarded by a majority decision of the PTSA Board of Directors and members and based on available funds.
