




BE AN INVOLVED PARENT: SCHOOL-HOME PARTNERSHIP






There is a myStudent app that can be downloaded on iPhone or Android



If a student misses:


- 1 day of school = 270 minutes of instruction

- Career Component through Xello








SCHEDULE CHANGES & POLICIES









